

Hot Weather & Inflatable Safety

At West Midlands Inflatables, your safety is our highest priority. While our inflatables are perfectly safe to use in warm weather, extra precautions are required during periods of high temperatures. Before and during your hire, please follow these important guidelines:

- **Bare feet only.** Surfaces can become very hot in direct sunlight, so we recommend users wear socks if necessary and always check the temperature of the inflatable before use.
- **Check the surface temperature.** If the inflatable feels too hot to comfortably touch with your hand, allow it to cool before use or keep users off until it is safe.
- **Keep everyone hydrated.** Ensure children and adults take regular breaks and drink plenty of water, especially during prolonged play.
- **Use shade where possible.** If practical, position the inflatable in a shaded area or create shade over waiting areas.
- **Adult supervision is essential.** A responsible adult must supervise the inflatable at all times and ensure users are not becoming overheated.
- **Avoid overcrowding.** Follow the maximum user numbers stated for your inflatable and separate users by age and size.
- **Weather monitoring.** While hot weather is generally suitable for inflatables, we continuously monitor weather conditions. If temperatures become extreme or other weather conditions (such as high winds or thunderstorms) make it unsafe, we may advise temporarily stopping use or, in rare circumstances, cancelling the hire for safety reasons.

Can the inflatable stay inflated all day?

Yes. Our inflatables are designed to remain inflated throughout the hire period. However, they should only be used when it is safe to do so. If the surface becomes excessively hot, we recommend pausing use until it cools.

What if it becomes too hot?

If you feel the inflatable is too hot to use comfortably, stop using it immediately. Allow it to cool naturally before resuming use.

Children's comfort and safety should always come first.

Please note: West Midlands Inflatables reserves the right to suspend or cancel a hire if weather conditions, including extreme heat, high winds or thunderstorms, are considered unsafe. This decision is made solely in the interest of the safety of our customers and their guests.
